Our Vaccination Policy: To insure the protection of all pets under our care, the following vaccinations must be up to date:

DOGS: DHLPP (DISTEMPER) **CATS: DIST-FVRC-C (DISTEMPER)**
BORDETELLA **RABIES**
RABIES

I give my permission for the veterinary clinic to update my pet(s) vaccinations in accordance with the above policy.

Medical Illness Policy: One of the advantages of boarding your pets at a veterinary hospital is that veterinary attention is readily available should the need arise. If one of your pets becomes ill, we will call the emergency number(s) listed below regarding your pet's symptoms, treatment options, and estimate of additional costs. If no one can be reached, however, please indicate your wishes below should your pet require treatment to relieve immediate discomfort or to resolve an important medical condition.

- Please perform whatever services the doctor deems necessary for the best care of my pet until someone can be reached. This includes only non-elective treatments and any necessary diagnostics.
- Do not administer any medical treatment until specific authorization is given.

PLEASE: No personal items such as bedding, toys, collars or treats are allowed to be left with your pet with the exception of cat carriers. Our staff will gladly supply these "extras" upon your request. If an item is accidentally left with your pet, we are not responsible for its safe return.

If your dog is on the once-a-month heartworm prevention and it will need to be given during his/her stay, we ask that you bring just the one pill needed and we will give it to your dog on the correct day. If you do not bring the pill, we will supply it, however there will be a fee charged to you.

CHECK OUT TIME BEGINS AT 8:00 A.M. AND ENDS AT 6:30 P.M. MON-FRI AND 4:30 P.M. SAT. Please notify us if there is any change in your pet's departure date or time. Pets can be picked up on Sunday between 2-5 pm ONLY. Pet's can not be picked up on holidays or after regular business hours. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

In order to maintain the health of all our boarders, we require that vaccinations be current. If your pet comes into the hospital with external parasites, it will be treated and a fee will be charged to you. Upon departure your pet is required to be bathed and a fee will be charged to you.

If I neglect to pick up my pet within 5 days of the date above & I do not call to make other arrangements, you may assume that the pet is abandoned and you are hereby authorized to dispose of the pet as you may deem best and necessary.
